# HELP WANTED...

## TERRACYCLE TIDBIT...

Did you know that we recycle old jeans through our recycling program at Trinity? Denim is not recycled through TerraCycle but through a company called "Blue Jeans Go Green". Based out of Arizona, they transform cotton denim material into creative insulation products for buildings, pet bedding and food/pharmaceutical packaging. And it costs us nothing to recycle! They pay all shipping costs!

It is estimated that 85% of all textiles end up in a landfill. You can reduce this number today by recycling your denim/jeans right here at Trinity! It must be at least 90% cotton and can be any color and in any shape- even pieces left over from craft projects are fine. Drop it off in our TerraCycle room or in the outdoor bins. And, as usual, thanks for recycling!
