## TERRACYCLE TIDBIT...

'Tis the season for giving and for wondering, "Can I recycle my wrapping paper?" The short answer is 'yes' but with a few important caveats:
*Plain wrapping paper is $100 \%$ recyclable - the plainer the paper, the more likely it will be recyclable.
*Metallic or shiny or glittery wrapping paper is NOT recyclable.
